Contest Rules

Eligibility

- Only students who are in grades kindergarten through 8 in Kentucky are eligible.
- Each submission must be original artwork created during 2023 by one student.

Artwork Guidelines

- Submitted artwork must depict a scene in your county that illustrates a reason why you love your county.
- The artwork must be horizontal 11" wide x 8.5" tall

Judging Criteria

- Technical skill: The artwork must display artistic skill in painting, drawing or digital art.
- Creativity: The artwork must be original in its expression of a personal vision or voice. It must be the student's own work and cannot be plagiarized or in violation of any copyright.
- Artist's statement: Along with the artwork, each student is required to submit a brief (1-3 sentence) statement that explains the scene depicted and why they love their county. See Deadline and Submission Requirements section for detailed information needed in statement.

Deadline and Submission Requirements

- Students from all Kentucky counties are eligible to enter.
- Submissions will be accepted beginning Aug. 18 and ending Oct. 13, 2023, at 11:59 PM EDT.
- Students must submit their artwork for consideration online or by filling out this application form.
- Only one submission per student is allowed.
- There is no entry fee.
